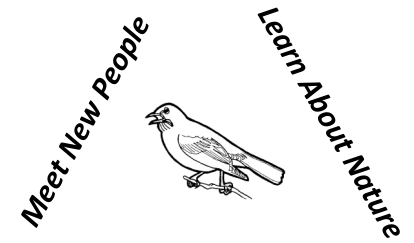
Friends groups have proven to be highly effective partners in working to improve the ability of refuges to meet their missions.
