



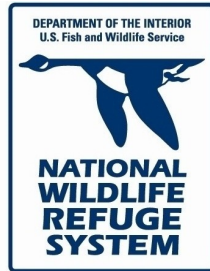
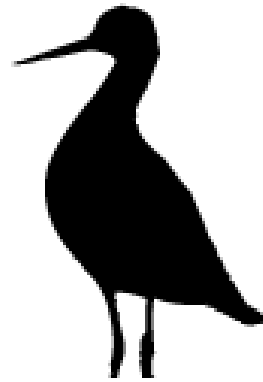

## SHOREBIRDS

Hagerman National Wildlife Refuge is home to more than 338 recorded species of birds. Some are permanent residents while others come from as far away as Canada seeking warmer weather during the winter months.

As you enjoy the refuge today look for these shorebirds in wetlands and at the water's edge, especially along the pad roads off of Wildlife Road. Take notice of their color and shape, and see how many you can find.

Shorebirds are some of the hardest birds to identify so be patient with yourself. Remember.... cars often make the best 'blinds' to help you see more wildlife.
